The plan will run for the financial year April 2021 to March 2022.

The funding available is £16,840 + £9354 carry forward from 2020/21 = £26,194

We will target funds and monitor impact by:

- enhancing the PE provision for children
- setting a new standard in children's activity levels
- meeting the inclusion requirements and the value for money criteria which will be set by Ofsted.
