

St Patrick Class

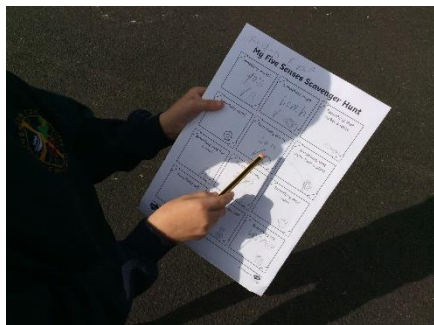
