

St David's Class Curriculum Overview **Summer 2**

English – We will be reading a selection of Greek myths and legends including Theseus and the Minotaur and Medusa. We will read about different Greek monsters and heroes before then writing our own Greek adventure quest. We will be finding out about the first Olympic Games held in Athens which will support our topic this half term.

Computing – Y3 children will learn how to use Branching Databases. Y4 children will find out about Artificial Intelligence and how it could change the world of technology.

PE – Athletics (Friday)

PE – Rounders (Friday)

PSHE – The children will learn about how to keep themselves safe in different scenarios. We will go down to the beach and meet the RNLI crew as part of this topic.

Science – Sound

The children will learn how sounds are created and modified. They will learn the anatomy of the ear and how our brains interpret different sounds.

Music – We will listen to different genres of music throughout the half term as part of our Worship. In addition to this, the children will listen to different styles and genres of music and discuss how it makes them feel.

Maths – In Y3 and Y4, the children will be learning about money, time, shape, statistics and position and direction. They will revise mental maths strategies in our CLIC sessions.

The Y4 children will sit their Times Tables Check in the beginning of June 2024 so please support them at home by asking them questions and quick recall of tables facts.

D&T – Mosaics and Grecian Urns

The children will plan, design, make and then decorate a mosaic tile and clay Greek vase.

RE – When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost? The children will learn about Pentecost and how Jesus' disciples felt at this time.

French – The children will listen to Goldilocks and the 3 Bears in French and learn some of the vocabulary to help re tell the story.

Geography and History: The Olympics Past and Present

The children will learn about the very first Olympic Games and how they compare with the games set for 2024 in Paris. We will look at the different sports and how new sports have been added over the years. We will locate the countries taking part on a world map.
